Eligibility

Storytellers aged 18 or over living and working in Scotland and who are rooted in the traditional artform of live, oral storytelling.

Collaboration with other artforms and/or international artists is also welcomed.

To apply

1. 8 bursaries will be awarded to a value of £2,500 each
2. Eligible artists (see above) may make **one** submission only for the Andy Hunter Storytelling Bursary
3. Please complete and return this form by **Monday 21st April**
4. You will receive an acknowledgement email from the Festival team as soon as possible, confirming receipt of your proposal
5. All applicants will receive a final decision regarding their proposal by **Friday 30th May**
